

# Faith Christian Academy (FCA) 2026-2027 Schedule of Payments and Fees

## • Tuition 4 yr. old (K-4):

- \* \$2,000.00 annually or \$150.00 monthly for ten months. (Half Day Program 8:30 a.m.-12:00 p.m.)
  - \* \$3,500.00 annually or \$350.00 monthly for ten months. (Full Day Program 8:30 a.m.-3:00 p.m.)
  - o K4 students should have reached the age of 4 by September 1<sup>st</sup>.

## • Tuition-Annual (K5 through 12<sup>th</sup>):

- \* K5 through third grades - \$7,485.00
  - \* Fourth through eighth grades - \$6,885.00
  - \* Ninth through twelfth grades - \$6,735.00

## • Discounts:

- \* Faith Baptist Church offers some private scholarship opportunities to self-pay families.

## • Before/After Care Times and Fees: (Multi-Child Discount available, must be paid in advance of the month, not funded by scholarships, non-refundable)

- \* 7:30 a.m.- 8:00 a.m. - \$60.00 per month
  - \* 3:15 p.m.- 5:30 p.m. - \$100.00 per month
  - \* Before and After Care combined - \$150.00 per month
  - \* After Care ends at 5:30 p.m., \$1.00 per minute will be charged after 5:30 p.m.

## • Fees:

- \* \$325.00 New Student Fee (non-refundable and required, in full **upon enrollment**, *not funded by scholarship*)
- \* Early Re-enrollment 2/1/26 to 2/28/26 NO CHARGE 😊
- \* \$20.00 per student late fee for re-enrollment from 3/1/26 to 5/22/26. (non-refundable; not funded by scholarship)
- \* \$40.00 per student late fee for re-enrollment after 5/22/26. (non-refundable; not funded by scholarship)
- \* \$250.00 K4 Book Fee (non-refundable)
- \* \$425.00 K5-12<sup>th</sup> Book Fee (non-refundable)
- \* \$300.00 Uniform Fee (non-refundable)
- \* \$100.00 SAT Fee (non-refundable)
- \* \$50.00 Media Fee (non-refundable)
- \* \$3.50 PACE Fee (for paces after a student completes 75 paces in a school year) (per pace price, non-refundable, not funded by scholarships)
- \* \$5.00 Failed Test Fee (non-refundable, not funded by scholarships, applies to A.C.E. students)
- \* \$50.00 K5 Graduation Fee not funded by scholarship, non-refundable)
- \* \$100.00 12<sup>th</sup> grade Graduation Fee (not funded by scholarship, non-refundable)
- \* Academic Support (small group setting, non-refundable)
  - o \$25.00 per hour
  - o \$3,000 annually
    - Scholarship funds from FES-UA **up to** \$3,000 above tuition and applicable fees may be used for Academic Support.
    - FTC & FES-EO scholarships do not cover Academic Support fees.
    - Academic Support requires meeting with administration for scheduling purposes.

## •Payment Process:

### Self-Pay

All self-pay payments are due the first of the month, are past due the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month, and a late fee may be applied. The normal payment schedule is from August 1<sup>st</sup> through May 1<sup>st</sup>. If a self-pay student is withdrawn prior to the last day of the month, one full month's tuition will be non-refundable. All fees are non-refundable.

### Step Up Scholarship Recipients

The normal payment schedule for a scholarship recipient is quarterly. The breakdown of the quarters is as follows:

July-September

October-December

January-March

April-June

The payment process of scholarship recipients is as follows:

Step Up for Students notifies the school that funds are available in student accounts.

FCA invoices the student's Step Up scholarship account for tuition and fees due in the current Step Up distribution.

Step Up notifies the family to log in to their EMA portal and view items needing approval.

Families must view the invoice submitted by FCA and approve the invoice for payment in their EMA account.

Step Up notifies FCA that invoices have been approved and submits funding to FCA.

FCA does not receive scholarship funds until parents approve invoices submitted through EMA. Parents are obligated to approve invoices within 10 days to ensure timely payments. If a parent or guardian does not approve a scholarship payment, the current financial agreement will be terminated by FCA and the student will be moved to a self-pay plan for the remainder of the school year.

Step Up for Students is not responsible for any student's tuition and fees. The parent/guardian is solely responsible for all educational costs incurred. Any unpaid monies will be the sole responsibility of the parent/guardian and will be due immediately. No withdrawal request for a scholarship recipient will be honored until 11 days after the beginning of a Step Up quarterly payment period.

### All Students

All tuition and fees for the current school year must be paid up to date prior to re-enrolling for the following year. FCA reserves the right to withhold services such as, but not limited to, class attendance, tutoring, participation in events including awards ceremonies and graduation, and Before and After Care if accounts are not kept current. Fees are for the use of items and do not constitute ownership of items. FCA retains ownership of all materials and all materials are to be used by currently enrolled students only. **Delinquent accounts forfeit all discounts.** No records will be transferred until any outstanding balance is paid in full.
